Jarosław Czaja is the founder and CEO of Autonomous Systems and Future Processing (FP).

Future Processing is a technology company, founded in 2000, currently employing over 900 specialists. FP implements IT projects from software for data acquisition and analysis, to advanced medical imaging systems and video inspection. It also offers outsourcing of software development services and creates custom software. It has its headquarters in Nowe Gliwice, a complex that is a business activity zone and business incubator.

From the beginning of 2019, Jarosław Czaja has been focusing on developing his newly founded company Autonomous Systems. The company focuses on creating advanced technological solutions enabling automatic driving of public transport. Autonomous Systems develops algorithms that support and automate the driver's work and vehicle fleet management, as well as strives to develop a safe and reliable system that allows driving at levels 3 and 4 of autonomy.

Jarosław Czaja obtained the master's degree in Computer Science in 2003 at the Faculty of Automatic Control, Electronics and Computer Science of the Silesian University of Technology. He also spent a year at Nottingham Trent University in Great Britain as part of a student exchange on the Erasmus project.
